Home online Learning Agreement 2020			

During the COVID-19 closure the Coastal Federation is offering home learning opportunities for our children. Below is the Home learning agreement which needs to be followed by children, staff and parents/carers to ensure that everyone is able to learn collaboratively in a safe environment. By accessing any home learning through our websites or google classroom you are agreeing to the Home Learning agreement.

Staff will:

- Consistently provide work according to the schedule shared by the school (e.g every Monday) unless a member of staff is unwell and can not provide work for that period - parents/children will be notified of this.
- Respond to children and parents only through their work emails (@coastalfederation.com).
- Continue to safeguard children by reporting to DSL (Designated Safeguarding Leads) any information which is shared with them about or by children that they believe puts the child at risk of harm.
- Communicate directly with parents/carers if they are concerned by the behaviour of children online.

Children will:

- Communicate with teachers through their school gmail account only.
- Use kind, respectful and appropriate words when communicating with staff or each other in google classroom (school expectations apply.)
- Approach work with a positive learning attitude to ensure they maximise the learning opportunities.

Parents/carers will:

- Appropriately supervise their children when they access online home learning to ensure they are acting responsibly and safely on the internet.
- Contact staff using the school email address of the member of staff.
- Appreciate that given the nature of home learning and the wider COVID-19 situation Staff do not have the capacity to make personal alterations to work to support personal circumstances e.g lack of internet access, posting hard-copies of work
- Contact a DSL or Headteacher if they are concerned by the conduct of their children, other children or a member of staff in google classrooms/emails.
